28-30 NOVEMBER 1989**

This symposium will be the major hydrological symposium for Australia and New Zealand for 1989 and 1990. It is being organised by the New Zealand Hydrological Society, and is co-sponsored by the national committee on Water Engineering of the Institution of Engineers Australia, and the Technical Group on Water of the Institution of Professional Engineers of New Zealand.

Papers are invited on the following themes:

1. Hydrological archiving systems;
2. Real-time data collection and warning systems;
3. Hydrological effects of land use change;
4. Water quality; including erosion and sediment transport;
5. Extrapolation of hydrological information;
6. Hydrological processes including groundwater;
7. Impacts of user pays principle;
8. Urban hydrology;
